APPEAL FOR INCOME. \$8,000 A YEAR WANTED FOR FIVE YEARS.

The Income of the University has for several years past fallen short of the amount necessary, owing to the following causes :—

1. The depression in real estate in Toronto, which has rendered several of the investments unproductive for the present.

2. The necessity of using a portion of the income-bearing capital for the purpose of making additions to the University Buildings which the extension of the work required.

3. The general fall in the rate of interest, which has seriously reduced the income derived from invested capital.

4. The unfortunate loss some years ago of a portion of the capital, equivalent to a reduction in income of \$1,500.
