BAD NEWS.

The Boers Showing up in Strong Numbers, And Threatening the Invasion of Natal - The War Not Yet Over.

LONDON, Sept. 22.—The war office has received the following despatch from Lord Kitchener, dated Pretoria, Sept. 21: "Kritzing, while endeavoring to force a passage of the Orange River near Herchel at one o'clock Friday morning, rushed the camp of a party of Lovatt's scouts. He failed to cross the river, but the scouts lost heavily. Lieut. Col. Hon. Andrew Murray and Captain Murray, his adjutant, were killed. Deeply regret the loss of Col. Murray, who throughout the war had led Lovatt's scouts with great gallantry.

"Under cover of darkness, the Boers managed to carry off a gun. They were promptly followed up and the gun was recovered in a smart engagement, in which Kritzing lost two killed and twenty taken prisoners."

Lord Kitchener also reports that the British captured by the Boers in the ambush near Schepers Nek, Sept. 17, have been released, and that the British casualties in the recent Vaalfontein engagement, when the Boers captured a company of mounted infantry and two guns, were one officer and five men killed, 23 men wounded and 6 officers and 109 men taken prisoners. He announces that these prisoners have since been released.

He further reports the capture of two commandoes, one consisting of 15 men under Commandant Kooke, who were taken together with their entire transport, west of Adenburgh, and the other, consisting of 54 men, including F. J. Botha, who were taken with 48 wagons and their belongings, 45 miles southeast of Carolina.

LONDON, Sept. 22.—In London, the speech of President Loubet, when proposing the health of the "Cape and Carolina" at the luncheon which followed the review at Bethany on Saturday, is in no way regarded as an indication of any intention on the part of the Russian Emperor to intervene in South African affairs. Even in Paris reflection seems to have convinced many persons that there was very little in the words, and that beyond a confirmation of the Franco-Russian alliance, little has been achieved by the visit of the Russian sovereign.

Lord Kitchener's latest despatches, although they contain good news as well as bad, have done little to reassure the public concerning the state of affairs. The loss of Lieut. Col. Murray, a brother of Lord Mansfield, is keenly felt. There is little doubt that further details will show it was a serious affair.

According to the latest advices from Cape Colony, the situation there is very serious. Owing to the sympathy and aid which the Dutch are giving the Boer commandoes, the British find it additionally difficult to obtain news of Boer movements.

At Pretoria the strength of the Boers in the field is now estimated at 11,000. If these figures be correct, the Boers must be constantly getting recruits. Their supply of arms and ammunition seems to be inexhaustible. In Boer circles in Holland, it is asserted that everything is prepared for a Dutch rising in both Cape Colony and Natal.

A most alarming letter from Cape Town is published today by the Daily Express. The writer says: "The Boers are overrunning Cape Colony. They are on both the coast lines and within 40 miles of Cape Town. Even the intelligence department does not know how many colonial rebels have taken up arms in the last fortnight.

"The town guard of Cape Town has been ordered to hand in the magazine rifles and ammunition, ostensibly because these are wanted at the front. Martini-Henrys have been served out instead."

PLEADED GUILTY.

The Assassin of President McKinley Acknowledged His Guilt, But the Plea was Subsequently Changed to Not Guilty - The Trial Will Probably be a Short One.

BUFFALO, Sept. 23.—Leon F. Gault was placed on trial this morning, charged with the murder of President William McKinley. He entered a plea of "guilty," which was subsequently changed to not guilty by the action of the court. All the events of the day tended to indicate that the trial will be short. Court opened at 10 o'clock, and before two hours eight jurors had been secured. It was noticeable that every man who acknowledged that he had not formed an opinion on the case was accused by the district attorney. Men who had formed an opinion or stated that they were prejudiced but were willing to be changed by evidence, were accepted by each side.

Justice Truman C. White, one of the oldest and most experienced of the supreme court justices, was on the bench. Immediately after the opening of the court, and after the prisoner had pleaded, ex-Justice Loren L. Lewis, senior counsel for the defendant, announced the plea of not guilty. He stated that the defendant was ready to act in behalf of the prisoner, and that he was ready to accept any suggestion that would result in the selection of counsel for the defendant. When the circumstances of the case were taken up, the defendant was asked to state his name. He answered "Leon F. Gault."

"I am familiar with these circumstances," said Justice White, in reply to every assurance that the prisoner would be treated as a criminal, and that during the progress of the trial he will receive such treatment as the law demands in any criminal case. "Before the day was over, the entire panel had been sworn and were seated in the box and had listened to a detailed and methodical statement of the facts of the case. The defendant was shown photographs of the interior of that structure and had been told by three surgeons what caused the death of the president and the result of the assassin's shot upon the various organs of the body. They had also learned why the fatal bullet had not been located.

The presentation of the government's case began shortly before 3 o'clock, when Assistant District Attorney Haller began to address the jury. His talk consumed scarcely five minutes. "We shall show," said he, "that from days prior to the shooting this defendant had premeditated the shooting of the president. We know that on the 6th of September the president would receive the populace in the Temple of Music; that on that day he went to the exposition, got into line with the people and approached the president so that he had a weapon concealed in his hand, and as the president extended his hand in kindly greeting, he fired the fatal shot. One of them took effect in the abdomen and caused that mortal wound which resulted in the president's death. That is the story we shall show you. Witnesses will tell you this story and I am sure that when you have heard the evidence you will have no difficulty in reaching a verdict of murder in the first degree."

The first witness, Samuel J. Fields, chief engineer of the Pan-American exposition, described the ground floor plan of the Temple of Music, and was followed by Perry A. Bliss, a photographer, who described the view from the interior of the afternoon was taken up with the testimony of three physicians, two of whom had attended the President during his last days, while the other performed the autopsy. Dr. Harvey R. Gaylord described the location of the wounds in the stomach and the direction of the bullet. The cause of death was attributed to the gunshot wound, but, fundamentally, he said it was due to the changes back of the stomach, in the pancreas, caused by the breaking down of the material of the pancreas was the result of the passage of the bullet. Dr. Herman Myer followed and his testimony brought out the fact that the reason why the fatal bullet had not been located was that the autopsy was because of the unwillingness of the President's relatives to have the body further investigated by their instruments. Dr. Myer and Dr. Mann, who followed him, both testified that the prime cause of death was the gunshot wound in the stomach. One effect of this wound was, they said, to cause the gangrene to form in the pancreas, and the spot of gangrene was as large as a silver dollar.

The prisoner during the morning evinced no interest whatever in the proceedings, but as the testimony was introduced he paid more attention to what was said and looked at the various witnesses closely. The probable duration of the trial, it is believed, can be placed at two full days.

DECLARED INSANE.

NEW YORK, Sept. 22.—Christina Miller, who came to this city from Berlin, N. Y., about ten days ago, announcing her intention to kill President Roosevelt and was placed in Bellevue hospital for the insane, has been declared insane by the doctors of that institution. Miller will be returned to New Hampshire.

TO RECLAIM SEAL ISLAND.

BOSTON (Transcript).
