3. Who were Rob Roy; Wolfe; Sennacherib; Absalom; United Empire Loyalists; Sinbad the Sailor; Drake; Roderick Dhu?
4. (a) Write sentences illustrating the meaning of the following words according as the accent falls on the first or second syllable; minute, desert, rebel, frequent, collect; (b) Write the past tense and the past participle of *sil, set, rise, raise, burst, go, see, drink, get, eat*.
5. (a) Define adjective and compare *little, late, far, old*. (b) Give the general rule for the formation of the plural in nouns, and name as many exceptions as you can.
6. Tell in your own words the story of "Bernardo del Carpio" or "The Glove and the Lions."
