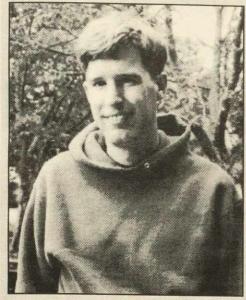


Question: What was the most important thing you forgot to bring to university?





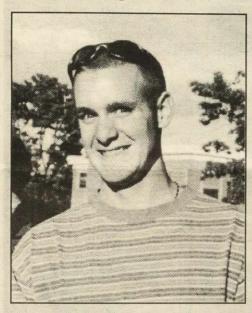

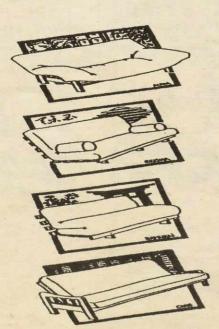
