With reference to Mr. Allen's memorandum of the 25th ultimo, hereunder, dealing with the manner in which subsidies granted by Provincial Governments should be credited I beg to say that I quite agree with Mr. Allen's suggestion that refunds be apportioned between the Trust Fund and Casual Revenue in the same ratio as the expenditures made.

In this connection may I respectfully suggest that Indian Agents in the Provinces which are subject to government subsidies be requested to arrange with the respective Provincial District Engineers or other appointed officers to have their departments send in the subsidies as soon as possible after the work has been performed, in order that this Department might take advantage of the money refunded on expenditures made from government appropriation to carry out other works before the end of the fiscal year.
