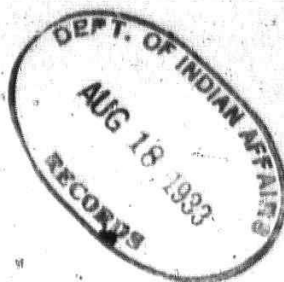

Dear Sir,-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 10th instant (No. 27109-10) regarding the above area.

1. In letter of November 21, 1932, the Dept. of the Interior pointed out that this quarter section had been transferred to the Dept. of National Defence through an oversight, by Order-in-Council of August 4, 1932, and asked if it could be made available for the use of the Indians.
2. In letter of December 13, 1932, the Dept. of the Interior was informed that this quarter section was not required for Military purposes, and was accordingly relinquished by the Dept. of National Defence.
3. It would appear that the matter now is for adjustment with the Dept. of the Interior.
