The Indian Act

**In the matter of Petroleum and Natural
Gas Permit No. 54.**

WHEREAS by permit dated 15th April, 1947 under the Regulations for the prospecting for and the disposal of petroleum and natural gas on Indian Reserves and Indian lands, you were granted the exclusive right to prospect for petroleum and natural gas on lands in Stony Indian Reserve No. 142B as described in the said permit,

AND Section 9 of the said Regulations requires that you submit to the Director of the Indian Affairs Branch a statement of the character of prospecting operations to be conducted and that you commence prospecting within ninety days of the issue of the permit; and provides that failure to commence prospecting operations within that period shall automatically terminate the permit,

AND WHEREAS you have not submitted the required statement and have not furnished geological reports as required by Section 10 of the regulations,

YOU are hereby notified that if you do not submit the required statement and commence prospecting operations by December 31st, 1947 without further notice application will be made to the Minister of Mines and Resources to terminate the permit.
