each Indian named on the Pay List as  
aforesaid is entitled under Treaty to the  
amount set opposite his or her name

And I make this solemn declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true, and by virtue of  
the Act passed in the thirty-seventh year of Her Majesty's reign, intituled: "An Act for the Suppression of  
Voluntary and Extra Judicial Oaths."
