 may, however, rest assured that  
 the S. S. Superintendent General has the  
 interests of the Indians with whom  
 you are more directly concerned as  
 well as of the Indians generally of  
 the Dominion at heart, and that  
 he will not fail to do his utmost  
 to secure your Band and the other  
 Indians interested in any rights  
 to the arrears of annuity to which  
 they may be entitled.
