We the Indians of Leon's Creek Reserve, known as Pavilion Indian Reserve No. 2, do hereby pray & request the Indian Affairs Branch to separate our reserve from the Pavilion Band. The reason for our request is that our reserve is far from the other Pavilion Reserve and is only reached by horse trail over a distance of twelve miles and across the Fraser River by small boat. We are so far separated from the other Pavilion Reserve that we need a Chief of our own and we would like to have our Band named Leon's Creek Band.
