

WITNESS: M-36793 L/Cpl. Campbell, R.J., 3 Cdn Med Regt Sig Sec, having been duly sworn States:
On 26 Dec 43 I was in the room, of which I have charge, with several signalmen including Sigm White. Sgt Jaffee came into the room and ordered White to go to the exchange and relieve the exchange operator. White said, "I won't go, I'm not supposed to go until 12 o'clock" or words to that effect. Sgt Jaffee ordered him to go again and White said "Like Fuck I will, I'll go when I'm supposed to". Sgt. Jaffee placed White under open arrest. I then left the room and came back a few minutes later. Sgt. Jaffee got two escorts and ordered White to go with them. White refused to go, using profane language. White said to Sgt Jaffee, "Don't you say too much or I'll knock your bloody head off". Sgt. Jaffee fell in two more escorts and gave White a minute to come quietly or be taken by force. White went with the escort using profane and insubordinate language to Sgt. Jaffee, "You're nothing but a bloody Yid and I'm not taking orders from you" or words to that effect. I spoke to several of my men about White and discovered that he had been drinking with them that night.

When I came in on 26 Dec 43 I had been drinking with two other men of the Signal Section. I was quite drunk when I was told to go on the switchboard and I used violent and insulting language to Sgt. Jaffee. If I had not been drunk I would not have behaved in such a manner.
