- Q. Mark the good land on this plan. (Witness did so)

Mr Commissioner Shaw: Is that island good?

- No, it is a sandbar. A.
- Mr Commissioner McKenna: Do you know anything about an application being made by these Indians for a reserve at Crab river?
- A. I know there has been an application made but I don't know wheth -er they would like to go there or not.
- Q. What do they want that land made a reserve for?
- A. For trapping.
- To make it a sort of headquarters during the trapping season?
- Q. Are there houses there which they could live in?
- A. I don't know.
- Q. Are there graveyards there?
- A. Yourse.
- Q. How many graveyards?
- A. Three.
- a. Have the Indians used that place for trapping for many years?
- A. Ever since I can remember.
- (Mr Young) Did the Indians live there permanently at any time? Q.
- Δ. Yes.
- Q. How lorguage would that be?
- I could not say, but our graveyards are there,
- Mr Commissioner Shaw: To whom gid the Indians make application for this reserve at Crab river!
- Δ. To the Agent.
- Mr Commissioner MacDowall: When?
- A. Last summer.
