

REGULATIONS

Regulation 1

1. The purpose of these regulations is to ensure that...

2. These regulations shall apply to all vessels of 200 gross tonnage or more...

(a) The radio-telephone station, exclusive of the antenna and associated equipment, shall be located on the vessel at a position which is as near as practicable to the bridge, and shall be so located as to be convenient to the operating position.

3. During the interim period between the date this Agreement comes into force and January 1, 1975, every vessel of 200 gross tonnage or more shall have equipment complying with Section I and II of this Regulation.

4. During the interim period between the date this Agreement comes into force and January 1, 1975, every vessel of less than 200 gross tonnage shall have equipment complying with either Section I or II of this Regulation.

Section I - VHF Radio-Telephone Equipment Operating in the Band 156-161 MHz

(a) The VHF radio-telephone equipment shall comply with the technical characteristics prescribed in the International Radio Regulations for Transmitters and Receivers using 50 kHz spacing between adjacent channels.
