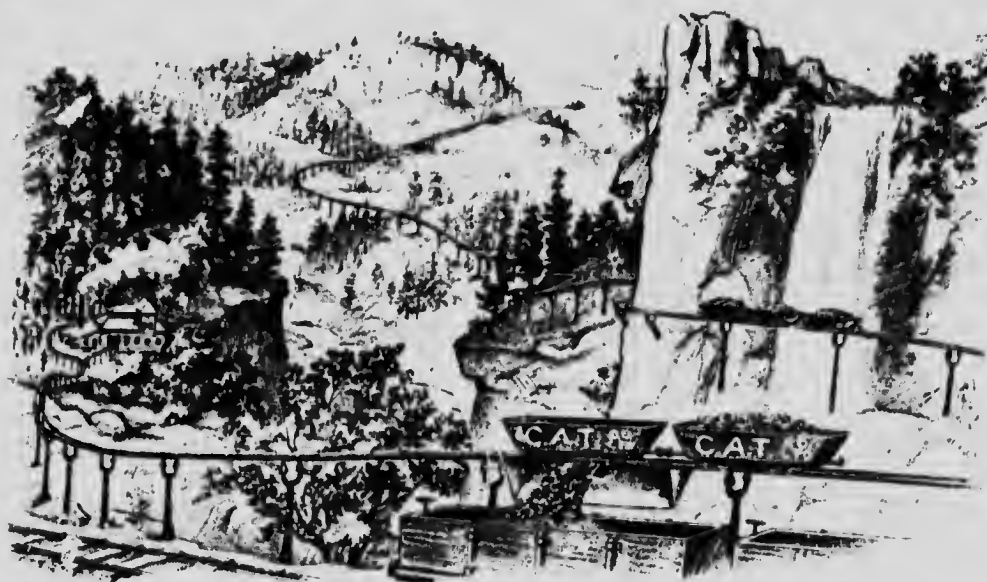


Benefit Locally

By the removal of most of the heavy loads from our country roads a very great decrease in the cost of repairs would be made in each county, probably to pay the interest on the cost of construction of the Carr System.
