CAP. III.

An ACT in addition to an Act intituled "An Act for the better Afcer-" taining and Confirming the Bound-" aries of the feveral Counties within " this Province, and for fubdividing " them into Towns or Parifhes."

THEREAS, the boundaries of the towns or parishes Preambles V of Westfield, Suffex, Springfield and Kingston as established in and by an act made and passed in the twenty fixth year of HIS MAJESTY's reign, intituled " An Act for the better " Afcertaining and Confirming the Boundaries of the feveral " Counties within this Province, and for fublividing them into ." Towns or Parifles, " have been found inconvenient.

I. Be it therefore enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council The parifies of Welfield, Sufand Affembly, That, from and after the paffing of this act, the Weffield, Suffer, Springfield faid towns or parishes of Wefffield, Suffer, Springfield and Kingston in King scours Kingston in King's county shall be bounded and limited respect- in the bounded. ively in the manner herein after deferibed, any thing in the faid recited act to the contrary notwithstanding, that is to fay: The faid town or parish of Westfield to be bounded on the Boundaries of North, South and West by the northern, fouthern and western boundary lines of the county, and on the East by a line running from the mouth of a creek which difcharges into the Long-reach at Devils Head, North-weft to the northern line of the county, and South-caft to the rear line of the lots fronting on the north-west shore of Kennebeckacis Bay, thence South-west to the north-eastern line of lot number twenty eight granted to Dennis Coombs, thence South-east to the fouthern line of the county including Kennebeckacis Ifland: The faid town or parifh Doundaries of of Suffex to be bounded on the North and East by the northern and eaftern lines of the county, on the Well and South by a line beginning at the mouth of Halfway-brook on the river Kennebeckacis and running North to the northern line of the county and South to the center of the Weston or cleared road, thence South, feventy fix degrees East to the fouthern line of the county, thence along the fouthern line of the county to the fouth eaftern angle thereof : The faid town or parish of Spring- Boundaries of field to be bounded on the North by the northern line of the Springfield. county
