RE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the Act 5 Victoria, con-Act passed in the Fifth year of Her present Majesty's Reign, entitled. An Act to revive the Act to amend the Act to regulate the Assize of Bread, and every matter, clause, and thing therein contained, shall be continued, and the same are hereby continued for One Year, and thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.

George the Third, entitled, An Act to provide for the Accommodation and Billeting of His Majesty's Troops, or of the Militia, when on their march from one part of the Province to another; and also, the Acts passed in the Fifty-first and Fiftythird years of His said late Majesty's Reign, in addition to and amendment thereof, and every matter, clause, and thing, in the said Acts contained, except so far as the same may be altered or amended by the Act hereinafter mentioned; and also, the Act passed in the Sixth year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Victoria, to continue and amend the said Acts, and every matter, clause, and thing, therein contained, shall be continued, and the same, except as before excepted, are hereby respectively continued for One Year, and thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.

BE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the Act 3, Wm 4, con Act passed in the Third year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, entitled, An Act to encourage the killing of Bears, Loup-Cerviers, and Wild Cats, and every matter, clause, and thing therein contained, shall be continued, and the same are hereby continued for Five Years, and thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.
