Press 1st, line 2d and 3d, leave out "hath at a great expense con"ftructed at the said City of Montreal," and insert "has by humble
"petition solicited the exclusive privilege of constructing, and has al"ready begun to construct."

The House divided on the question:

Yeas 16 Nays 3

So it was carried in the affirmative, and the Bill was accordingly amended at the Table.

On motion of Mr. Viger, seconded by Mr. Papineau, junior;

ORDERED, that the following amendment be made to the Bill: viz.

Press 1, line 30 and 31, leave out "the date hereof, and," and insert "and after the passing of this Act, to."

The faid amendment was accordingly made to the Bill at the Table.

Mr. Viger moved, seconded by Mr. François Caron;

That the Bill do pass, and that the title be, An Act to grant to John Molson the exclusive right and privilege of navigating one or more Steam Boats, between Quebec and Montreal, on the River St. Lawrence.
