The Order of the day being read.

On motion made and feconded,—Ordered, That the Governor or Commander in Chief for the time being, with the advice and confent of his Majefty's Council, be requefted to iffue a warrant on the Treafurer, for the payment of the cofts and charges to be incurred by printing the Acts of the General Affembly, and the Journals of this Houfe in the prefent Seffion, and that this Houfe will make provision in the next Seffion, for fupplying fuch money out of the public revenue.

A meffage from his Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, requiring the attendance of the House in the Council Chamber.

Mr. Speaker, with the House, having attended, his Excellency was pleased to give his affent to the following Acts,—viz.

"An act for continuing and amending an act, intitled, an act for laying an Impost."

"An act in addition to an act, intitled, an act for relief against absconding Debtors."

" An act in addition to an act, intitled, an act for the better extinguishing Fires that may happen within the city of Saint John."

" An act to provide for the support of a Light-House to be built upon Partridge-Island.

" An act to continue fundry acts of the General Affembly which are near expiring."

" An act for regulating the Fisheries in the different rivers, coves and creeks of this Province."

" An act in addition to an act, intitled, an act for regulating Pilots."

"An act to empower the Justices of the Seffions in feveral Counties in this province, to make fuch regulations respecting Markets and Ferries within such Counties, as may be found neceffary."

"An act to amend an act, intitled, an act for regulating the exportation of Fish and Lumber, and for ascertaining the quality of the same." Money voted for printing the Journals and Laws.
