THE General Assembly having been by Proclamations prorogued until this day, then to meet for the Dispatch of Business,

The House being met—

A Message from His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor, by the Gentleman Usher of the Black Rod, requiring the attendance of the House in the Council Chamber.

The House attended, and being returned—

Mr. Partelow, by leave, presented a Petition from Thomas Nisbet, John Haws, George Waterbery, C. D. Everitt, John Hooper, and 156 others, Mechanics and Tradesmen of the City of Saint John, praying for an Act of Incorporation under the name of *The Saint John Mechanics' Whale Fishing Company*; which he read.

Ordered, That the said Petition be received and lie on the Table.

Mr. Partelow moved for leave to bring in a Bill, to Incorporate *The Saint John Mechanics' Whale Fishing Company*.

Leave granted.

The said Bill being brought in, was read a first time.

Mr. Speaker then reported that His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor had been pleased to make a Speech to both Houses, of which Mr. Speaker said he had, to prevent mistakes, obtained a Copy; which he read to the House, and is as followeth:—
