

for your readiness in voting the supplies, and have to regret that no Bill of Appropriation has been agreed upon to make those supplies available for the present year. The administration of the Government will by this step be much embarrassed; and the country, at least for a time, deprived of the benefit arising from the sums voted for the promotion of several objects of internal improvement. Under these untoward circumstances, I shall use my best endeavours to conduct the Government with undiminished zeal for the public good, sincerely hoping that whenever I am enabled again to call the Legislature for the dispatch of business, it will meet with a disposition to come to a right understanding on all points of difference between them."

The President of His Majesty's Council then said—

"It is His Excellency the Lieutenant Governor's will and pleasure, that this General Assembly should be prorogued,—and this General Assembly is prorogued accordingly until Tuesday the 17th day of June next."
