MAY DAY BRINGS THE UNITED STATES STREET RAILWAY 2000 Machinists of York Out--Marine Traffic affected--Building Trade Strike.

Special Wire to the Courier. New York, May 1.—Owing to the unusual ferment in labor circles, union leaders predict that the May Day parade here this afternoon will be one of the most notable labor demonstrations New York has ever seen.

STREET CAR MEN OUT. Pittsburg, May 1.—A strike of street car men here began shortly after midnight. Operations were completely suspended on all lines.

MACHINISTS OUT. Youngstown, O., May 1.—About 2,000 machinists employed at the various industrial plants of the city did not report for work this morning and a number of these plants are operated in a crippled condition, several being entirely closed.
