The Chill of Onset

The characteristic onset of lobar pneumonia (also known as lung fever, pleuro-pneumonia and sometimes pneumonitis) is with a sudden chill with little, if any, preliminary indisposition. The abruptness of this chill is impressive and has led to deplorable misunderstanding in the past on the part of the laity. In short, the frequency of a chill with the onset of pneumonia is a strong prop for the catching cold delusion. But every educated physician knows today that the chill of onset is a result, a symptom of an infection already consummated, and no more a cause or forerunner of the pneumonia than is the chill a cause of malaria or of erysipelas or of septicemia, diseases in which chill is a striking symptom. Yes, every physician knows that, but not every patient knows it, and that is the trouble. Don't those most effective advertisements, press bulletins from the bedside of the great and near-great, still convey the information that the Senator has taken a heavy cold and is threatened with pneumonia?

ANSWER—Yes, I'd have my gall-bladder removed pronto if it should trouble me. The gall-bladder or gall-sac is a superfluous structure and we are as well or better off without it. The "some" who "say" it shortens life to have it removed merely show the extent of their ignorance or may be it is from a desire to have you experiment with some other alleged treatment. Certainly there is no other cure for gall-stones but operation, although some stupendous humbugs are exploited as "remedies."

Dry, Itching Dandruff
My hair is oily, but my scalp is caked with dry itchy dandruff. (Miss C. H.)

ANSWER—Carefully rub into it about one-fourth of the area of the scalp each night, parting the hair here and there, some of this ointment. Shampoo once a week. Salicylic acid..... 20 grains
Precipitated sulphur..... 1 dram
Ointment of rose-water..... 1 ounce

Syphilis and the Kiss
I would like your advice whether syphilis is ever contracted through kissing and whether there are any symptoms by which one may recognize it. (H. E.)

ANSWER—A great many cases of syphilis have been contracted by kissing a person who has the disease (and many a person has syphilis, though healthy looking to the casual observer).

The first sign of syphilis is the hard sore (called chancre, pronounced shank-er) which appears at the point of inoculation (as on the lip in kiss infection) from two to five weeks after the date of exposure or inoculation. This sore is often single not very large, and perhaps mistaken for a "cold sore." Of course a diagnosis can be made only by your physician. Incidentally, a girl of my acquaintance contracted syphilis from kissing.

EXCHANGE RATES.

New York, Oct. 29.—Disparity of exchange rates, is tending to reduce greatly the first post-bellum rush of trade between Great Britain and the United States, according to Paul E. Derrick, general manager of the American Chamber of Commerce in London.

Huge purchases by British firms in the United States were cancelled, Mr. Derrick said, when the depreciation of silver came about. The high cost of goods, through the operation of adverse exchange rates, he explained, made it impossible to market to the British consuming public.

SILVER SHIPPED.

Omaha, Neb., Oct. 25.—Two hundred million dollars' worth of silver bars have just been shipped secretly from Washington across the United States enroute to Indian, according to Raymond T. Baker, Director of the United States Mint. The bars were each worth \$1,000. The special train carrying the silver pigs came into Omaha on the various lines and went over the Union Pacific from


