Buffalo, May 18 .- Half a million do lars' worth of water front property was destroyed by fire yesterday. The Erie elevator, a wooden stucture with its bins filled with grain, was com-pletely destroyed. The south end of the Erie Railroad company's eastboun freight sheds was damaged by the flames and a large quantity of flou there was ruined by water.
