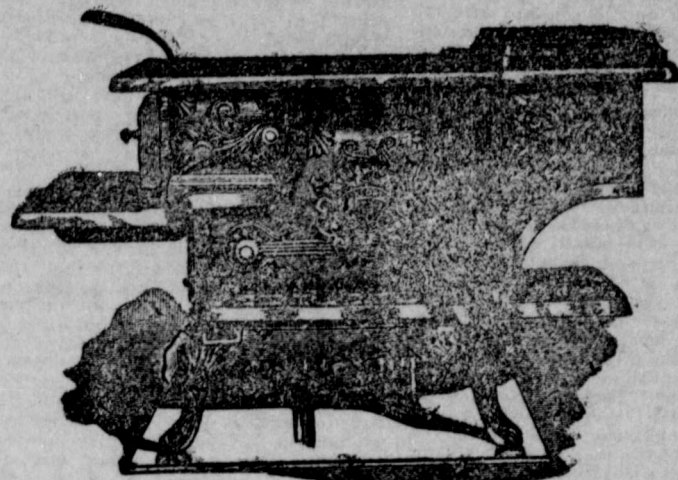

Ball for Ontario Shoppers.

Toronto, Oct. 12.—Steamship freight agents here state that the war in the Transvaal will cause very serious inconvenience to shippers of Ontario produce. At least half a dozen steamers have been withdrawn from the services to Montreal and Boston, while rates have twice advanced, and still another advance is looked for at the end of the week. The only way out of the difficulty, agents say, will be the diversion of traffic to New York and Baltimore. There seems to be little prospect of attracting sufficient tonnage to Montreal and Boston before the close of navigation to carry the enormous quantities of freight offering.
