ALEXIEFF TELLS OF JAP REPULSE

Destroyed Eight of Enemy's Ships All Told.

ZASSALITCH BLAMED FOR LOSS

The Czar Grieving Over Disaster at the Yalu—Rejoicing at Tokio.

St. Petersburg, May 3.—High Admiral Grand Duke Alexis has received the following official telegram from Viceroy Alexieff reporting the Japanese attempt to block Port Arthur early this morning: "I respectfully report to your highness that a fresh attack was made by the enemy last night with the object of obstructing the entrance to the port, and that it was successfully repelled. At 1 o'clock this morning five torpedo boats were perceived near the coast from the eastern batteries. Under the fire of our warships and the batteries they retreated southward. At 1:45 o'clock the first torpedo boat was sighted, and was fired upon by the batteries and the coast defense vessels. Three-quarters of an hour afterwards our searchlights revealed a number of torpedo boats, the entrance of the harbor from the east and southeast. The coast defense vessels Gremiashki and Otavashi, and the gunboat Glikk repulsed each by a well-directed fire. Altogether eight ships were sunk by our vigorous cannonade, while the remainder were launched from our torpedo boats and by the explosion of several submarine mines. Further, according to the reports of the officers commanding the batteries and the gunboat Glikk, two Japanese torpedo boats were destroyed. The Japanese batteries and warships ceased fire, subsequently firing only at intervals on the enemy's torpedo boats which were visible on the horizon. All the ships carried quick-firing guns, with which they maintained a constant fire. Up to the present thirty men, including two mortally wounded officers, who took refuge on a launch, have been rescued from the wrecks by us or picked up. The inspection of the roadstead and the work of saving the enemy's men were hindered by the heavy sea running. We suffered no casualties with the exception of a seaman belonging to the torpedo boat destroyer Egoval. On the appearance of the first torpedo boat, accompanied by the enemy's torpedo boats, I boarded a launch and proceeded to the Otavashi to take immediate measures for repulsing the torpedo boats. With me were Lieut. Zankelski and Captain Eberhardt, of the naval general staff, Lieut.-General Spasskoy, and other dignitaries at the same time, and Gen. Loschinsky, chief of the defense force of the forts, was on board the Glikk."

Port Arthur, May 3.—Noon.—A Japanese squadron appeared off Port Arthur after daybreak today, and engaged the forts and warships. The light is still proceeding. Thirty Japanese prisoners have been captured. The Japanese torpedo boats were sighted, and the Russian land batteries and the gunboat Glikk repulsed each by a well-directed fire. ZASSALITCH BLAMED. The St. Petersburg correspondent of the Echo de Paris says that Gen. Kuropatkin, in telegraphing to the Emperor, blamed Lieut.-Gen. Zassalitch's obstinacy in refusing to retreat in time, despite the orders received. The Japanese artillery, the correspondent says, included 18 siege guns, which were brought from Yokohama on gunboats and landed on the Korean bank of the Yalu. The long range of these guns enabled the Japanese to silence the Russian batteries on the opposite bank.

NICHOLAS DUNOUMED. St. Petersburg, May 3.—The Emperor is understood to be greatly grieved over the losses sustained on the Yalu. Those who have seen his majesty say that he was dumfounded when he was informed of the heavy fighting which attended the passage of the river. As is well understood here, Gen. Kuropatkin's programme did not contemplate such resistance to the

Japanese advance. It is said, moreover, that Kuropatkin himself was equally surprised and so chagrined over the miscarriage of his plans that he sent his first telegram to the general staff and not direct to the Emperor.

THE BRAVE JAPS. A Port Arthur dispatch says: "After the sinking of the fireships this morning many dead bodies were seen floating about the harbor. They were collected by the Russians and buried. The Japanese were German in number and few of their crews were rescued. The sighting of the enemy was due to the vigilance of the men in the watch towers and on the gunboats. The new attempt to bottle Port Arthur was on a grander scale than any previous one. The Japanese showed extraordinary bravery. The attempt to close the harbor failed."

REJOICING AT TOKIO. Tokio, May 3.—9 p.m.—The greatest popular demonstration since the beginning of the war occurred in Tokio this evening. The capital is showing the joy of the Japanese victory on the Yalu. Thousands of people, half of whom are women, paraded the streets in celebration of the triumph of their arms. The most numerous group in as many different quarters, and they later were all centralized in a great pagoda. The students composed one parade, and all carried lanterns. The streets are still lined with thousands of people, and the entire city is decorated with flags and lanterns.

GERMANS FOR RUSSIA. Leipzig, Saxony, May 3.—The Tageblatt today prints a letter from Riga, European Russia, in which the writer says that when the news of the Russian success at Gensan, Korea, was published Friday last, the harbor searchers, who are Government officials, called on the vessels in port to display their flags in honor of the event. THE RUSS LOSS. London, May 4.—A Seoul dispatch says: "Later reports of the Russian reverses on the Yalu are the effect that the Japanese captured 28 small rapid-fire guns, besides 20 field guns. They also captured 30 Russian officers, and a number of men, many of whom were found hiding in the underbrush by Japanese soldiers. The Russian losses, however, are not as heavy as the Japanese losses. The Russian army is resting, burying its dead and caring for its wounded. The Japanese thoroughly occupy the area over which the fighting extended, and are now scouring the hills country for the Russian forces. A St. Petersburg dispatch says: "The official report of the appearance of a number of Japanese ships off Kai Ping and Sinu Chen, on the west coast of the Liao Tung Peninsula, below New Chang, forbids the disembarkation of Japanese troops with the intention of cutting off Port Arthur. This war may now be said to have reached its final stage. The Russian fleet in the Yalu, showing the severe losses suffered by the Russians who have removed 800 wounded alone to Feng Wang Cheng."

THE RUSSIANS OUTNUMBERED. St. Petersburg, May 4.—According to information just obtained from the general staff, Zassalitch's estimate of the Japanese force consisted of fifteen rifle battalions, of 800 men each, and five batteries of forty guns. One regiment of three battalions and two batteries stationed at Antung did not participate in Sunday's fight, and retired without loss. The heights of Kai Ping and Sinu Chen were held by four regiments and four batteries, about 10,000 men and 32 guns, against 60,000 Japanese and 160 guns, in addition to six 12-pounder siege guns landed from the gunboats. These guns are considered by the Russians to have been responsible for Gen. Zassalitch's defeat, as the Russian guns were of a light field pattern, with some mountain pieces. The general staff asserts that Gen. Zassalitch had no reserves nearer than Feng Wang Cheng. Reserves, it is said, were unnecessary, as Gen. Zassalitch's mission was only to observe and harass, but not to impede the Japanese. "It is like

Gen. Kuroki's luck that Gen. Zassalitch should be such a headstrong commander," said an officer. It is admitted by the general staff that the Japanese flanking move affected the whole of the twelve battalions and three batteries at Kai Ping and Sinu Chen, which accounts for the desperate character of the fighting. The Twelfth and Twenty-second Regiments suffered the heaviest losses. A number of officers were killed or wounded and the gunners of the captured pieces were either killed, wounded, or made prisoners. One battery had every man killed.

JAP LOSS HEAVY. The crews of the Japanese fireships which were sunk this morning while attempting to block the channel tried to save themselves by putting to sea in boats. A majority of them were killed by the Russian machine guns and rifles. Some of the survivors were picked up. At daybreak a number of the Japanese were seen clinging to the masts and funnels of the sunken vessels and were rescued by the Russians. Thirteen of the wounded Japanese have since died. The Russians supplied the survivors with food and clothing, and the wounded were taken to the hospital ship Mongolia. During the morning the Japanese torpedo boats remained in the offing, and were fired on at long range. At 9:30 o'clock it was launched the first of the Japanese fleet in the vicinity, and that two of the enemy's launches were run ashore. The town is quiet.
