



Oppose Proposed Plans.

Oppose Proposed Plans. Several property owners on Pember-ton road who are averse to the pro-posed local improvement work on that thoroughfare, have requested the coun-cil to make some change in the scheme of improvement. The city intended to grade and macadamize the street from Fort street to Rockland avenue and lay permanent cement walks on both sides. Some of the owners suggest that as the road is narrow the sidewalk be laid only on the east side of the street from the end of the present ce-ment walk to Rockland avenue, placing only a curb on the west side, while

It is also suggested that the city do not consider the laying of boulevards as it would involve the sacrifice of a number of fine trees and any steps taken by the city to remove the trees will be strenuously opposed.
