STRONG OPENING FOR CORN, BUT CLOSED AT THE LOWEST, 1 CENT DECLINE — WHEAT CLOSED WEAK ½ CENT LOWER — PROVISIONS DULL AND WEAK.

Liverpool—Wheat opened strong, ¼ higher. Spot corn in Liverpool is ¼ higher than yesterday, and still ¼ premiums over May there.

Opening wheat, May, 5.9¾; July, 5.9½; closing, wheat, May, 5.9¾; July, 5.8¾.

Opening corn, May, 4.2¼; July, 4.1¼; closing, corn, May, 4.1¾; July, 4.0¾.

Paris—Wheat and flour 5 higher. New York—Wheat opened quiet, ¼ lower.

Chicago—Wheat opened active, ½ lower, now ¾ higher than opening; wheat is a buy on all weak spots for the moment, specially July.

Corn opened active and strong, ¾ higher; on higher cables and small stocks. Corn abroad is still the cheapest feeding article, so that advance in prices does not in any way check consumption. As we said before, situation is very strong and higher prices must rule ultimately. Oats opened ¼ lower, but on the strength of corn sold ½ higher and strong.

Provisions opened strong for May pork 20 cents higher and are now weak. Market is not a broad one, one or two heavy operators are bulling market.

Car lots corn estimates, 235; receipts, 148 contract, 61; shipments, 189,722.
