

PHYMATIDÆ.

Phymata Wolffii, *Stal.* Common. August. On *Solidago*.

NABIDÆ.

Coriscus subcoleoptratus, *Kirby*. Common. June, July.

Coriscus inscriptus, *Kirby*. Common.

Coriscus propinquus, *Reut.* Not common. May.

REDUVIDÆ.

Sinea diadema, *Fab.* Abundant. August, September.

Diplodus luridus, *Stal.* Common.

Darbanus palliatus, *Prov.* (*Petite Faune Ent. III.*, 182, n. sp.)

Evagoras marginata, *Prov.* (*ibid.*, n. sp.)

Opsicetus personatus, *Linn.* Not common.

Pygolampis pectoralis, *Say.* One specimen. May 31.

LIMNOBATIDÆ.

Limnobates lineata, *Say.* (*Prov. Petite Faune Ent. III.*, 193)

HYDROBATIDÆ.

Limnotrechus, n. sp. ? One specimen.

SALDIDÆ.

Salda major, *Prov.* One specimen.

Salda deplanata, *Uhl.* One specimen.

Salda sp., probably undescribed. Common. (Hull.)

BELASTOMATIDÆ.

Zaitha fluminea, *Say.* Abundant.

Belostoma americanum, *Leidy*. Very common.

NEPIDÆ.

Nepa apiculata, *Uhl.* One specimen. (Leamy's Lake.)

Ranatra fusca, *Pal. Beauv.* Common.

NOTONECTIDÆ.

Notonecta undulata, *Say.* Abundant in lakes and streams.

Notonecta undulata, *Say.* *Var.* almost white. Not common.

Notonecta irrorata, *Uhl.* Not common. (Hull Brook.)

Plea striola, *Fieb.* Common. (Hull Brook and Canal.)
