chickens," his feeling on the subject broke forth; and with tears he said, "O, ma freens, ve ken hoo I've striven tae gie se the words o' wisdom; ye ken hor I've keepit ye year aifter year, as a hen covers her chickens, but I doot aifter a' there's some deucks among ye; sae mony are ga'in aff tae the water!" The effect of these words was electrical; they were passed from lip to lip, and from house to he se, and the oddity of the figure somehow so hated the circumstances of the religious in the town that, for that time at least, the agitation came sud-denly to an end; and Mr. Dunlop and the other ministers in Dumfries were no more troubled with secession from their flocks.
