transmission, typesetting, printing form production, printing, print processing, book-binding and paper converting, paper cardboard and products of the paper, cardboard and foil processing industry, and printing inks. In 1986, DRUPA attracted 1 465 exhibitors from 33 countries and 373 656 visitors. Ten Canadian companies are expected to attend in 1990.

Interclean '90 (National Stand) Amsterdam, Netherlands – May 8-11, 1990

Professional Maintenance and Cleaning
Twelve Canadian companies will exhibit
at Interclean '90, a biennial major world
fair aimed at promoting maintenance,
cleaning, refuse processing and municipal
cleaning. The exhibition is open to all
interested in industrial maintenance
systems and equipment, cleaning and
restoration equipment for streets, parks,
stadiums, building facades and
monuments and equipment for processing
refuse. In 1987, it attracted over 300
exhibitors and 20 209 visitors. Twelve
Canadian companies reported 12-month
projected sales of \$3.7 million.
