VISIT OF A GUINEAN MINISTERIAL DELEGATION TO CANADA, MARCH 19-23

The Department of External Affairs announces today that a ministerial delegation from Guinea headed by the Minister of Economic and Financial Domain, Mr Ismael Touré, is visiting Canada from March 19 to 23.

During the visit the Guinean Delegation will have discussions with the Honourable Renaude Lapointe, Speaker of the Senate, the Honourable Jean-Pierre Goyer, Minister of Supply and Services and Adviser for Francophone Affairs to the Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Vice-President of the Canadian International Development Agency, Mr. Léo Dorais, the Vice-President of the Export Development Corporation, Mr. Verne MacKay, and the Assistant Deputy-Minister of the Department of Industry, Trade and Commerce, Mr. Claude Charland.

A luncheon at the Department of External Affairs will be offered by the Honourable Jean-Pierre Goyer.

The Guinean Delegation will leave Ottawa for Montreal March 21 where it will have discussions with representatives of the Department of Industry and Commerce of the Quebec Government and with many Canadian companies.
