CANADA-SWITZERLAND NUCLEAR COOPERATION AGREEMENT

The Right Honourable Joe Clark, Secretary of State for External Affairs, announced today that Canada and Switzerland have concluded an Agreement for Cooperation in the Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy. The Agreement was signed in Berne on December 22, 1987. Nuclear cooperation between Canada and Switzerland dates from the 1950's and the new Agreement replaces a 1958 Agreement for Cooperation in the Peaceful Uses of Atomic Energy between Canada and Switzerland. The new Agreement is comprehensive in scope reflecting fully the nuclear non-proliferation commitments of each country.
