BANKRUPTCY AND INSOLVENCY

REPORT OF BANKING, TRADE AND COMMERCE COMMITTEE— INQUIRY WITHDRAWN

On the Inquiry of Senator Hayden:

That he will call the attention of the Senate to the Report of the Standing Senate Committee on Banking, Trade and Commerce on the subject-matter of the Bill

C-12, intituled: "An Act respecting bankruptcy and Insolvency", tabled in the Senate on 8th October, 1980.

Hon. Royce Frith (Deputy Leader of the Government): Honourable senators, this Inquiry also stands in the name of Senator Hayden. I am informed that this report need not be discussed for some time, probably not until the New Year. I have Senator Hayden's authority to ask leave to withdraw this Inquiry, it being understood that he may wish to draw attention to that report at a later date.
