

The House went again into Committee of Ways and Means.

(In the Committee.)

The following Resolution was adopted:—

Resolved, That towards making good the Supply granted to His Majesty, on account of certain expenses of the Public Service for the financial year ending 31st March, 1914, the sum of \$23,470,316.65 be granted out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Canada.

Resolutions to be reported.

The said Resolution was reported, read the second time and concurred in, and the Committee of Ways and Means to sit again at the next sitting of the House.

Mr. Rogers then presented a Bill No. 249, An Act for granting to His Majesty, certain sums of money for the Public Service of the financial year ending the 31st March, 1914, which was read the first and second time, considered in Committee of the Whole, reported without amendment, and ordered for a third reading at the next sitting of the House.

On motion of Mr. Lancaster, the Bill No. 97, An Act respecting the Canadian Northern Branch Lines Company, was withdrawn and the fees paid thereon refunded, less the cost of printing and translation.

The House then adjourned at 4.20 o'clock, a.m., until 11 o'clock, a.m., this day.
