with a view to inquire into and report upon the best means of relieving the country from its extremely serious railway condition and financial burden consequent thereto, with power to send for persons, papers and records and that the said Committee be re-appointed with the same personnel and, therefore, that it consist of the Honourable Senators Beaubien, Black, Buchanan, Calder, Cantley, Côté, Dandurand, Graham, Haig, Hugessen, Horsey, Jones, Hardy, McRae, Meighen, Murdock, Parent, Robinson, Sharpe and Sinclair.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Senate proceeded to the consideration of the second Report of the Standing Committee on Internal Economy and Contingent Accounts.

The said Report was adopted.

The Senate adjourned.
