

gild and treasurer, and twelve persons in the leet for baillies: But it is not determined by the act, whether the said leets should contain one and twenty different persons; and the usage appears to be in the contrary, which therefore ought to prevail. And further finds, decrees and declares, That the deacons extraordinary, or not of the council, have a vote in chusing provost for the absent members of the ordinary council at the annual election, in all steps where they have a right to be present: And also finds, decrees and declares, That the right of calling the council, ordinary and extraordinary, belongs to the provost or preses of the meeting; and upon an execution returned of the members being summoned by the said provost or preses, his order, thirteen of the ordinary, and seventeen of the extraordinary council, may proceed and act in the same manner, as if all the members were present: But if the provost or preses shall happen to neglect, or shall refuse to call a council on Wednesday, the ordinary council-day, a majority of the said council may, forty-eight hours preceding the ordinary and stated time of meeting, require the aforesaid provost or preses, under form of instrument, to call a council, and upon his refusal, or neglect to comply with the demand so made, the majority of the said council may meet on the said usual and stated time, and proceed to do business. And finds, decrees and declares, That the council, ordinary and extraordinary, have the sole power of right of governing the Trinity-Hospital, and cannot delegate the same to any other person or persons whatsoever: And decrees and ordains the accounts of the town to be listed and audited within the time to which the said accounts relate, or within three months after the expiration of the said year, and that no article of deportment of the town's money can be allowed, unless the sum be sufficiently verified: And finds and decrees, That the expenses of the
