**BILL.**

An Act to amend the Act relating to the custody of juvenile offenders in the province of New Brunswick.

**H**IS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

**1.** Chapter 33 of the statutes of 1893, intituled *An Act* 1893, c. 33,  
**5** *relating to the custody of juvenile offenders in the province of* section added  
*New Brunswick*, as amended by chapter 59 of the statutes of 1894, is further amended by adding to it the following section:—

**10** “**17.** The Governor General, by warrant under his hand, Transfer of boys from industrial home to penitentiary.  
**15** may at any time, in his discretion, on the application of the Attorney General of the province of New Brunswick, cause any boy who is imprisoned in the Boys' Industrial Home under sentence for an offence within the law of Canada and for a term of years for which he might have been sentenced to imprisonment in a penitentiary, to be transferred to the Dorchester penitentiary for the remainder of his term of imprisonment.”
