

ST. JAMES'S CLUB.

CONSTITUTION.

1. This Association shall be known as ^{Name.} the "ST. JAMES'S CLUB" of Montreal, with a limited membership of 1,000.

2. Politics and religious questions of ^{Politics and Religion.} every description shall be absolutely excluded from the objects of the Club.

3. Each candidate for admission shall ^{Candidate} be proposed by one member, and seconded by another by a proposal in writing, to be inserted in the book of Candidates, and signed by both mover and seconder; and shall be balloted for at any ballot which may take place after the lapse of one week from the time of such proposal, provided the name of the Candidate and his proposer and seconder have been posted in the coffee-room, under the hand of the Secretary, at least one week before the day of ballot. No ballot shall be valid unless twenty members actually ballot; and one black ball in seven shall exclude.
