

ARTICLE 11TH.

Granted.

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That the present Capitulation shall be executed according to its form and tenor, without being liable to failure under pretence of reprisals, or the non-performance of any preceeding Capitulation.

The present Treaty has been made, and Duplicates kept by us. Signed and Sealed in the Camp before Quebec, the Eighteenth day of September, in the Year one thousand seven hundred and fifty-nine.

The same evening we took possession of the Town, with some Companies of Grenadiers, who mounted the Guards, agreed upon to prevent irregularities, and such other Guards as were judged necessary for the Security of the place.

There were two Battalions *marched into* the Town, the Barracks not being in a condition to receive any more for the present.

We found the Buildings in general in a most ruinous condition, *and* infinitely worse than we could have imagined; for, besides those burnt, there was hardly a house in the Town that was not injured by either shot or shells; nor were they habitable without some repairs.

The Fortifications, which consisted only of the fronts towards the Land, were little more than half-finished, and could have held out but a *very* few days after the opening of our batteries; for, there being neither ditch, cover'd-way, nor out-works, the Scarp-wall was exposed to view in many places from the top of the parapet to the foundation.
