que, (1) rel. pron. (dir. obj.) which, that, whom; (2) inter. pron. (dir. obj., or predic. nom.) what; *que faire?* what is to be done? what are we to do? *qu'est-il arrivé?* what has happened? *qu'y a-t-il?* what's the matter? *que diable!* the deuce! the dickens!

que, conj., after compar., as, than; *ne... que*, only.

que, conj., that; often after a noun denoting time or repetition.

que, exclam., adv., how (much, many)! *qu'il est beau ...!* how beautiful it is...! *que de patience!* what patience.

quel, *quelle*, adj., inter. and exclam., what, of what kind.

quel, pron. inter., what, who.

quelque, s., adj., some, a few; *quelque chose*, m., something.

quereller, v. a., take to task, scold.

querelleur, *le*, adj., quarrelsome; (subst.) *qu'trelosome man*.

question, n. f., question.

questionner, v. *se* question, ask questions (of).

queue, n. f., tail; *faire la queue* (also *faire queue*), stand one behind another waiting their turn, wait their turn; *se mettre à la queue*, take one's place in file, take one's turn, get into line.

quinzaine, n. f., (group of) fifteen; a fortnight.

quinze, num., fifteen; *quinze jours*, a fortnight.

quitte, adj., quits, clear, 'square.'
