



BAN WILHELM'S PICTURE FROM GERMAN SCHOOLS

Berlin, April 1.-All the Prussian district and provincial government school authorities have been notified by Herr Haenisch, minister of religion

and education, that pictures of former Emperor William and the former crown prince may no longer be hung in the schoolrooms.

The order originates from an incident in an East Prussian school, where the teacher put ex-Emperor William's picture in an attic after the revolution, but was ordered by the authorities to hang it up again, where upon he entered a protest.
