

THE TREASURER'S REPORT FOR 1863.



The Treasurer begs to report as follows :—

The number of members at the commencement of 1863 was :

Honorary.....	11.
Life.....	1.
Corresponding	25.
Associate.....	106.

The number of members elected during 1863, was 53.

The number of members withdrawn do. 6.

Your Treasurer appends the usual abstract of receipts and disbursements during 1863.

The former, consisting of Subscriptions received, interest on deposits, and Parliamentary Grant, amount to \$4066.28.

The latter, composed principally of purchases for the Library, Specimens for Museum, printing, fittings of rooms, and Secretary's expenses, amount to \$3551.66.

The available funds at this date are :

\$544.62

to which may be added the nominal balance of subscriptions due amounting to \$110, and your Treasurer does not know of any outstanding claims against the Society of any consequence, (say \$60.)
