ENGLAND AND RUSSIA.

Expressed in London Over a Relaxed Tension.

London, July 24.-(New York Post Cable.)-The peaceful solution of the Malacca affair has been received here with a feeling of unmeasured relief, for the incident was one of just that kind out of which wars come, and every Englishman desires peace now above all things else.

If the Petersburg is a warship she ought not to have passed the Dardanelles; if she is a commercial vessel, she cannot commit belligerent acts without laying herself open to the charge of piracy. The British government is showing itself anxious to assist Russia to find a way out of the impasse, and it is hoped the incident will now be closed.
