

First Objective Carried.

At 5:30 a.m. our guns suddenly opened an intense bombardment, and the infantry assault began. The long line of battalions advanced in good order immediately behind the rolling barrage maintained by our artillery. In spite of the difficult conditions of ground, much of which was reduced by the unfavorable weather of the preceding days to a succession of vast puddles of sticky mud, our first objectives were carried in scheduled time.

On the left our troops encountered specially stiff opposition, and as the morning wore on, it became evident that a portion of the German line on the slopes of Hill 145 was still held by the enemy. This section of the German defences was very strong, with numerous underground caves and tunnels, and there is no doubt also that the enemy fought to retain this vital portion of the ridge with greater determination and higher courage than he displayed on most other parts of the front.

Passing through the wide belts of German wire which fringed the plateau through which our heavy artillery had broken lanes, the advancing battalions came to the steep eastern slopes of the Vimy Ridge, and were the first of the Allied troops since the German reoccupation in 1915 to look down upon the level plains of Doual. At their feet lay the villages of Farbus, Vimy and Petit Vimy, and beyond they could see Ballleul. Willerval and Oppy, Arleux and Mericourt. Here in the woods that fringed the eastern edge of the ridge we captured several batteries of German guns' hastily abandoned with their ammunition.
