Cloth, especially cloth of good quality, is very scarce all through the country. The cloth which is used in the city is made at the mills, and the cloth which is used almost exclusively by local tailors, is practically impossible to come by.

The shortage in British houses is that the labor situation over there since the war has not cut the production of the mills greatly.

Local tailors state that rather than use the cheaper American cloth they have put up their prices in line with an upward trend.
