HIGH COST OF LUMBER.
The Canadian Lumberman tells why the price of lumber is high. In 1919 men's wages in the lumber industry were \$28 to \$29 a month; in 1920 they were \$70 to \$85 a month (both being in addition to board and housing), according to the New Brunswick Lumbermen's Association in accounting for the high cost of lumber. In 1918, stumpage was \$1.50 and mileage \$1; today we pay \$2.50 stumpage, \$8 mileage and \$2.50 a mile for protection; also we have workmen's compensation for logging, sawing, rafting, milling and loading, with a separate rate on each, and this still further adds to the cost; in addition there is the heavy business tax, the new tax. The logging engineer for one of the Montana districts of the Forest Service, as a result of an investigation in the larger band mills of the district, shows in detailed figures why the lumber is so high. He says that the cost of lumber is \$40 a thousand feet more, though the timber is bought on the stump for from \$8 to \$12 a thousand, and logging operations cost \$14 to \$20 a thousand. From the pond to the saw, including the manufacture of the rough lumber, the cost is \$11 to \$16 a thousand, these figures being based on records from mills sawing 600,000,000 feet of lumber during the season of 1919.

SALE OF AREAS NEAR MINTO IS COMPLETED TODAY

Price Said to Be About \$150,000—Americans to Get Out About 200 Tons a Day.
(Special to The Times)
Fredericton, N. B., Aug. 12.—The transfer of coal mining areas near Minto, owned by A. D. Taylor, G. H. King, M.P.P., and the Northfield Coal Co., will be completed here this afternoon. The International Pulp and Paper Company, represented by Col. P. Holmbeck, New York, wants the property. The purchase is made in the name of the Miramichi Lumber Co., A. D. Taylor will be manager of the operations, which will be consolidated.
An output of more than 200 tons a day will be reached within two months. The purchase is made on account of coal shortage and the Winnipeg strikes, all local customers and trade will be taken care of by the new owners. The price is in the vicinity of \$150,000.

SOCIALIST MEETINGS STOPPED BY POLICE

Street-Corner Gatherings During Week-End Get Short Shift.
(Toronto Globe)
Absent from the corner for more than five years because of war-line restrictions, Socialists returned over the week-end to the corner of Shuter and Yonge streets and found, as soon as they mounted their boxes, that they were not free to expand the virtues of socialism. One meeting was interrupted on the corner on Saturday night, and another last night at the corner of Albert street. Both meetings were broken up by the Patrol-Sergeant Marshall of Dundas street station.

They were Socialists of an extreme type," said Sergeant George Lydiatt, who was in charge of the station. "They were discussing the Winnipeg strikes, and Patrol-Sergeant Marshall broke up the meetings. The meetings were stopped on account of what they were preaching."

When the police interrupted the Saturday evening meeting and brought the speaker from his box, Shuter street was completely blocked with Socialists and pedestrians who had been attracted to the gathering. Students from the Labor College on Wellington street came to the meeting, and a fair amount of literature on the Soviet system, incidentally explaining its virtues to all who were willing to purchase the pamphlets. On Sunday evening Mrs. Joseph Knight and Max Armstrong, well known Radicals, brought their boys to Albert street. They had secured a crowd of several hundred when the police stepped in.
