Report of the Board of the Infirm Ministers' Fund.

At the first meeting of your Board the Officers of the past year were re-elected, viz., Rev. G. E. Day, M. D., Chairman, and Rev. A. Cohoon, Secretary-Treasurer.

Your Board are thankful to be able to report that the matter of the Marshall property has been arranged without loss to the Board. As enough was not offered at the day of sale to cover the debt and costs of foreclosure, it was bidden in by Rev. J. H. Saunders, who has kindly acted as our agent, and to whom our thanks are due. It has since been sold to a responsible party for \$850.00, \$100.00 down, and \$750.00 remaining on mortgage at 7 per cent.

Aid has been granted to two of our aged Ministers and two widows.
