RULES OF ORDER.

RULE 1st.—At each annual meeting the Letters from the Churches shall be at once handed in; from which the clerks shall immediately make out a list of Delegates.

RULE 2nd.—After religious worship the officers shall be chosen. The choice of a Moderator shall be made by ballot.

RULE 3rd.-At every sitting business shall be opened and concluded with prayer.

RULE 4th.—Brethren invited to a seat with us, may speak on all subjects under consideration, but vote on none.

 $Ruls \ 5th.-No \ subject \ shall \ be \ discussed \ without \ a \ motion \ there on \ being \ first \ made \ and \ seconded.$

RULE 6th.—Every speaker shall address the chair; and no person shall speak oftener than twice on the same subject, unless by permission of the body.

RULE 7th.-When a church is received into the Association the Moderator shall give to one of its delegates the hand of fellowship.

RULE 8th - At the commencement of each sitting the Minutes of the last one shall be read and corrected, and of the last before the final adjournment.

RULE 9th.-All resolutions shall be presented in writing.

RULE 10th.-Motions made and lost shall not be recorded unless so ordered at the time.

RULE 11th.-No delegates shall be allowed to leave the Association before the business is finished, without permission of the body.

RULE 12th.-These rules shall be distinctly read from the chair at the opening of the Session.
