NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS APRIL 30, 1988

- Corporate organization
The name of the Company was changed from York Campus Radio/CJRY to CHRY Community Radio Inc. during the year.
- Significant accounting policy
Fixed assets are recorded at cost. Depreciation is recorded on the declining balance basis at 20% per annum.
- Bank loan
The bank loan bears interest at 12% per annum and is secured by an assignment of the book debts and a general security agreement.
- Loan payable
The loan payable bears interest at a compound rate equivalent to the University of York's average monthly yield on short term investments which was approximately 8.5% as at April 30, 1
