VIA implements student rates

On February 3, 1986, VIA Rail Canada implemented student fares for a trial period un til May 31, 1986, exclusively in the Atlantic Region.

This trial program was adopted in response to the demands of the student market, and will serve as a means to test results prior to proposed implementation on a

national basis. The fare is a flat 33% off one-way travel. Accomodations such as dayniters, berths. available at regular supplemental charges. Student fares are available to full-time post-secondary students upon presentation of a valid current student I.D. card with

photograph. One-way discounts and stopovers are permitted.

Certain restrictions apply on roomettes and bedrooms are Fridays, Sundays and at Easter according to the train service. These restrictions are only applied to those services or periods which would present capacity problems.

The special fare applies to travel between stations in the Maritimes and stations in the rest of Canada. It is also available for travel within the Provinces Maritime


